Booze Raffle

1. Tournament is sanctioned by the USBC and is “USBC Certified”.
2. **Bowlers will use their highest USBC league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the previous season. If no average last year, use highest current USBC average, 21 games or more, as of 4/1/10. If current USBC average is more than 10 pins higher than 2008-2009 highest average, this year’s average if more than 21 games at time of entry will apply per Rule 319a-2. Rule 319e accumulative tournament average adjustment rule has been waived. If no current year average or (2008-2009) year average, Men will enter @ 180 average and women will enter @ 160 average.**
3. **Bowlers are responsible for verifying his/her average, whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain or others. If the submitted average is lower than required and results in a lower classification or more handicap, the bowler’s score is disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average per Rule 319a.**
4. **Handicap will be 90% of 220 (over 220 will be scratch).**
5. **Open to all USBC certified bowlers for the current season. Non-USBC members can qualify for entry in the tournament by:**
 - 1) **virtue of purchasing an associate membership card and paying National dues (\$10) plus the actual dues charged by the local and state association the bowler is joining. When local and state dues are not known, adult associate dues will be \$21 or**
 - 2) **pay a participation fee of \$5.00. (See Rule 300c for complete details.)**
6. **100% of Prize money will be returned in Cash Prizes. 1 in 6 Participants will cash. Prize money will be determined based on the number of entries. Reporting previous tournament winnings per Rule 319d will not apply. Youth Bowlers will not receive cash prizes per Rule 400.**
7. **Multiple participations are permitted and will be governed by USBC Rule 315.**
